

Barry Stamp Says Reduce The A518 Speed Limit Now

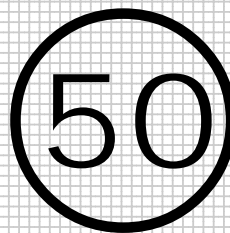
Over the past couple of years the number of fatalities on the A518 between Haughton and Newport has continued to rise. In response the County Council and Police have agreed that what was needed was a few extra signs and the occasional visit from a mobile speed camera team! **Barry Stamp believes this is not enough.**

Barry is calling for positive action to improve safety on this road. As part of this campaign he is demanding that the County Council reduce the speed limit and use permanent and regular mobile speed cameras to ensure the new limit is enforced.

To help persuade the Council to make these changes he is organising a petition and needs your help.

When **Barry Stamp** was County Councillor for Gnosall he fought hard to get the Council to produce an A518 Route Strategy. This document highlighted the road safety problems and listed improvements which could be made. **Barry** also fought to get money put in to the Council budget to get these works carried out. However he was unhappy that while the document stated that excess speed was a problem on the road there was no plan as to how this could be tackled. **Barry** did not think this was good enough and had already started pressing the Council on this issue. However since losing his Council seat very little has happened! It appears the money which was in the budget is no longer there; only some elements of the work have been carried out; nothing has been done about the excess speed; and recently it even appeared that the A518 Route Strategy had been forgotten as the County Council and the Police agreed that more work was needed to identify safety problems with the road!

Once again they don't seem bothered about the safety of local residents.

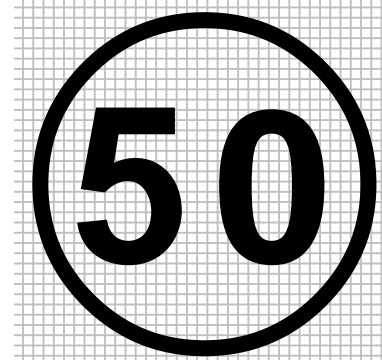
